Subject: Suspension of TGSP Personnel for Misconduct and Incitement of Agitation.

Last few days some TGSP personnel have conducted themselves in agitations inside Battalion campus in Telangana as well as on streets of several places including Hyderabad in Telangana. With a view to uphold discipline and integrity within the Telangana Special Police (TGSP), the following personnel involved in misconduct are placed under suspension for unbecoming of government servants, including incitement of others for agitation among Battalion personnel. The concerned individuals are found to have acted in violation of conduct rules and have engaged in behavior contrary to the one expected from government servants.
