**Dear Rahul Gandhi ji,**

History has repeatedly shown that whenever India's youth believe they have been wronged or insulted, they do not retreat-they rise. You, of all people, should know this. Congress party has witnessed it through history, from the resistance against the Emergency under Smt. Indira Gandhi to Telangana's statehood movement during the UPA era under Smt. Sonia Gandhi, where lakhs of young people, under the leadership of Shri. KCR Garu, fought relentlessly until Telangana became a reality. Every generation has reminded governments that the self respect of young people cannot be ignored, intimidated or insulted.

It is in that spirit that I write this letter to you. As the principal campaigner of the Congress Party, the leader who personally sought the mandate of Telangana's youth and the person who handpicked Mr. Revanth Reddy as Chief Minister, the political as well as moral responsibility ultimately rests with you.

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At a time when the entire country celebrates engineers as nation-builders and recognizes the role of students in shaping India's future, your **Chief Minister of Telangana, Mr. Revanth Reddy, chose to describe engineering students as "criminal waste."** He went even further by making deeply offensive remarks against engineering teachers. These are not casual political comments.

They are a direct insult to lakhs of engineering students striving for a better future, to every parent sacrificing to educate their children and to every teacher dedicating a lifetime to building the next generation of innovators. A Chief Minister who brands engineers as "criminal waste" does not diminish engineers- he diminishes the dignity of the constitutional office he occupies.

It is part of a disturbing and repeated pattern. **Long before these latest remarks, Mr. Revanth Reddy dismissed university students as a "beer and biryani batch," reduced student movements to the work of "thugs" and repeatedly ridiculed young people whenever they questioned his government.**

He also made derogatory and irresponsible remarks against members of the teaching fraternity, hurting millions of educators who dedicate their lives to shaping India's future. His message has been unmistakable-that who questions the government deserve abuse instead of answers.

Mr. Rahul Gandhi, stop lecturing the nation on democracy, constitutional morality and the dignity of India's youth, and start practising those values within your own party. Every speech you deliver on these principles loses credibility when your own Chief Minister publicly humiliates students, engineers and teachers without facing any accountability. Your refusal to condemn such remarks is not an oversight-it is a conscious political choice.

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Silence in the face of such an insult amounts to endorsement, and your inaction makes you equally responsible for this disgrace. If you truly stand for the values you preach, prove it through action-not speeches.

**Let me say this without any ambiguity.** The engineers building India's digital economy, the scientists taking India to new frontiers, the teachers nurturing tomorrow's innovators, the entrepreneurs creating employment and the students preparing to serve this nation are not "criminal waste." They are among India's greatest national assets. **The real criminal waste is the enormous potential of Telangana's youth under a government that responds to aspiration with arrogance, to criticism with intimidation and to hope with broken promises.**

**Mr. Rahul Gandhi, leadership is not measured by speeches delivered against political opponents. Leadership is measured by the courage to correct one's own.**

If you genuinely believe that India's youth deserve dignity and respect, then that commitment must begin with your government in Telangana. **This is no longer just about Mr. Revanth Reddy's words; it is about the values your party stands for.**

As the leader who personally sought the trust of Telangana's youth, handpicked Mr. Revanth Reddy as Chief Minister and continues to defend his government, you too bear moral and political responsibility for this disgraceful insult.

- We demand that you, Mr. Rahul Gandhi, issue an unconditional and public apology to every student, engineer, teacher and young citizen of this country for the shameful remarks made by your Chief Minister, Mr. Revanth Reddy. As the leader of the Congress Party, you cannot disown your responsibility for this grave insult.

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- We demand that you immediately direct Chief Minister Mr. Revanth Reddy to tender an unconditional public apology to every engineering student, engineering teacher, university student and young person he has repeatedly insulted, and publicly withdraw his offensive remarks without any qualification or justification.
- Accountability must replace rhetoric, and action must replace political hypocrisy. If you defend Mr. Revanth Reddy, you endorse his insult. If you remain silent, you legitimise it.

Mr. Rahul Gandhi, Telangana's youth have heard every word. They have witnessed every broken promise, every betrayal of trust and every insult directed at their aspirations. Telangana's youth are watching. They are remembering. And when democracy calls upon them once again, they will deliver their verdict through the power of the ballot.
